

The old window is repairable. Valuable old blown glass should be preserved, appropriate tools and the right paints, putty go to the thing.








Traditional doors are repairable.



The decorative wooden front door is removable.











The old stoves and their details are recyclable






Old stairs are mostly values that should either be kept or, if not impossible, disassembled.
